Application and Decision Dates for admission to 2024-2025 school year

The following are the dates applicable for admission to First Year:

- The school will commence accepting applications for admission on 1st October 2023
- The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on 21st October 2023 at 1pm
- The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is 10th November 2023
- Applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission by 21st November 2023

Notes:

The school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.
